

The purpose of this Maine Area Inventory is to enable NA members and groups to assess how well the Maine Area Service Committee of NA (MASCNA) is making our message of recovery available and accessible to everyone in our community, and to make recommendations to MASCNA wherever possible to meet this end. Here is a quick review of some of our vital services:

MASCNA Treasury: Most recent annual 7th Tradition totals \$3018, with operating costs at \$3,300, which shows that 7th Tradition donations alone are too low to sustain costs. Additional sources cover operating costs and quarterly donations to Region: EMASCNA Phoneline donations, Literature sales, the Miracle Convention and the occasional fundraiser.

Public Relations: Meets monthly with varied participation, however current lack of experienced members results in need for PR training to conduct presentations at facilities and to professionals who work with addicts. Working with Regional PR and North East Zonal Forum PR Ad Hoc to fulfill this need. Hosted several flyer hanging days this past year to fulfill primary purpose. PR finds cost for flyers and materials exceed \$75 monthly budget.

Phoneline: With service averaging \$150 per month, with recent costs spiking to around \$300, the costs are unsustainable for MASCNA budget. Service is now partly funded by EMASCNA. Phoneline Coordinator has faced ongoing hurdles to reduce cost, with efforts meeting recent success, with more options to explore. Phoneline needs more volunteers to answer calls from struggling addicts.

Hospitals and Institutions: Subcommittee holds five commitments per month in four different facilities. Subcommittee meetings are held monthly. Unable to bring commitments into more facilities with current participation and budget at this time. Monthly budget is \$75 for books and I.P.s. Committee often finds that the budget fails to meet facility requests for NA literature. Request to increase H&I budget was declined on grounds that the increase is unaffordable for MASCNA.
